Regarding: Humphrey among first physicians in the U.S. to become registered in vascular interpretation

Owensboro, KY, January 18, 2007 – Roger L. Humphrey, MD, FACS is one of five physicians in Kentucky to pass the American Registry for Diagnostic Medical Sonography's (ARDMS) Physician Vascular Interpretation examination. He has received a new ARDMS credential, which has been designated as Registered Physician in Vascular Interpretation (RPVI).

The focus of the PVI examination is on interpretation of vascular laboratory test results, rather than on performing the examinations. The PVI examination – and the RPVI credential – provides a vehicle for documenting expertise in vascular laboratory interpretation for physicians of all specialties who work in the vascular laboratory.

Humphrey interprets vascular studies performed in the vascular laboratory at Ohio Valley Surgical Specialists (OVSS.) He is a partner in OVSS' eight physician general, thoracic, and vascular surgery practice. OVSS has locations in Owensboro, Tell City, Indiana, and Hartford, Kentucky.
