Headline: Local Surgeon Receives High Marks on Recertification Exam

Owensboro, KY, December 16, 2002, 11:00 a.m. – Dr. Roger Humphrey has successfully completed the recertification process with The American Board of Surgery. His exam score placed him in the 99th percentile of surgeons taking the 2002 examination for recertification in surgery.

Dr. Humphrey's scope of practice encompasses the surgical treatment of breast disease utilizing minimally invasive techniques such as stereotactic breast biopsy and sentinel node biopsy, vascular surgery, non-cardiac chest surgery, skin cancer removal, hernia repair, gallbladder surgery, laser surgery, and in-office treatment of hemorrhoids and spider veins. He is a Fellow of the American College of Surgeons and an Assistant Clinical Professor of Surgery at The University of Louisville. He graduated from The University of California at Berkeley with highest honors, attended medical school at The University of Texas Health Science Center, Dallas Southwestern Medical School, and completed his residency at The University of Louisville Affiliated Hospitals.
